Sunday – Day 1

Monday – Day 2

Waterpark Eco Tours

Capricorn Caves

The spectacular Capricorn Caves are a unique system of above-ground caves in a limestone ridge situated 23km north of Rockhampton. They have been attracting visitors since their discovery by Norwegian pioneer, John Olsen, in 1882.



Tuesday – Day 3

Dreamtime Cultural Centre

On offer are a variety of activities including Didgeridoo demonstrations, a Torres Straight Island Village to explore, Djarn Djarn dancers, Boomerang throwing workshops, a sandstone cave tour and a self-guided native plant tour.



Historic Tour

The majesty of Rockhampton's historical architecture has captured the hearts of visitors for decades. Many of the buildings in the city area are famous for their historical value.



Rockhampton Botanic Gardens

Regarded as one of the best gardens in regional Australia, this breathtaking sanctuary holds several excellent specimens of palms, cycads and ferns as well as a zoo with both Australian native animals and foreign beauties.



Singing Ship

This beautifully designed monument was erected on the Bi-centenary of the discovery of Australia by Captain James Cook in 1770. As you sit and look out at the stunning views, be swept up in the harmonies produced the ship's expert engineering.



Wednesday – Day 4

Langmorn Homestead

George and Leonie Creed and family today operate a typical Australian cattle station stocked with a herd of red Brahms. The 26,000 acre (nearly 11,000 hectare) coastal property is situated between Rockhampton and Gladstone, just 15km from the Bruce Highway. Langmorn Station was originally purchased by George's great-grandfather, Thomas Creed in 1869 after recently arriving in Australia with his wife, Edith and two young sons. George's grandfather (also George) was born soon after they arrived. The comfortable homestead is a large restored "Queenslander" built in 1873 from local timber. The original shingled roof, now covered with iron, is still visible along the verandah. A fantastic day of true blue country hospitality.



Thursday – Day 5
