We thank you for your enquiry and are pleased to advise that the Iwasaki Foundation Limited is operating a Special Holiday Scheme for **disadvantaged** persons.

Please find enclosed Information Sheet, a Flyer and a Circular Letter explaining eligibility in more detail.

Also enclosed is a Declaration Form and Special Guests' Particulars Form, both of which need to be completed, signed and returned to confirm any booking.

For your information, the Foundation was established by the generosity of our late benefactors, Mr and Mrs Yohachiro Iwasaki, for the purposes of providing subsidized Motel-style week long (approximately) Holidays for **needy** persons including the disabled, infirm and aged, and is under strict control of a Board of Governors, including 10 Australian and 4 Japanese members, two of whom are the son and grandson of Mr & Mrs Iwasaki.

To provide these holidays, the Iwasaki Foundation has been negotiating with the Bayview Towers Resort situated in the Heart of Yeppoon, and accommodation for our Special Guests has been made available to the Iwasaki Foundation. The Special Guests are invited to enjoy the facilities and surroundings of the Resort. Bayview Towers is situated on the beachfront, with access to shops, restaurants, Public transport, clubs, etc. It is the Iwasaki Foundation's pleasure to be able to offer to its Special Guests the benefits of such an environment, which might otherwise be denied them.

To be eligible for a subsidised holiday, guests with the aged pension, the waiting period is three years, for "needy", and disabled persons and carers the waiting period is one year. Eligibility is dependent on the views of the Board of Directors.

The cost per person is \$50.00 booking deposit, payable EIGHT (8) WEEKS prior to booking date, the balance of \$225.00 to be made payable two (2) weeks prior to arrival.

Total cost of Subsidised Holiday: \$275.00 per person twin share. This subsidy is for 3 meals per day and accommodation only.

If you are travelling up to Rockhampton by Tilt Train (ETA Rockhampton 7.30 – 7.45 pm Sunday,) using your rail passes, we will organise bus transfers **per YOUNG'S BUS SERVICE to and from the Resort for an approximate cost of \$13.40 per person return, payable two (2) weeks prior to booking date.**

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CIRCULAR LETTER TO ALL SENIOR CITIZENS AND PENSIONER GROUPS.

Dear Sir or Madam

As Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Iwasaki Foundation, I would again like to draw your attention to the Foundation and the benefits that can derive from it for people who qualify for its benefit by way of a holiday, as sponsored by the Foundation.

Its principal aim is to provide a holiday for persons who are aged, infirm, disabled or needy people, with the emphasis on 'needy'. The fact that a person is aged does not necessarily qualify a person for the benefits provided, as persons in that category may have an income either by way of full pensions or means which may preclude them from being categorised as 'needy'. The interpretation of what is intended to mean is that they would not be able to have the type of holiday provided under the Trust Deed, unless this were the only means by which they could afford it.

Infirm or disabled persons can be more easily defined, as there would be no doubt that some organisations would be aware of their financial disadvantage, and would have knowledge that they are indeed needy and could not afford a holiday as promoted by the Foundation in any other way.

The scheme has proved to be very popular indeed, and is booked out in advance for some considerable time, but nevertheless, applications are considered and accepted should there be cancellations which do occur from time to time.

It is important that at all times, both the applicant and the Foundation, act strictly in accordance with the provisions of the Trust Deed which is required to conform to the Laws of Queensland.

In the case of disabled persons, the criteria are generally self-evident. Needy persons could include people who are aged with very little income and who could only afford a holiday on a heavily subsidised basis, and could be categorised as being in circumstances where only by having a subsidised holiday for their welfare could they afford a holiday.


If there is a need for the 'special guest' to have a carer, consideration may also be extended to the same conditions as apply to the 'special guest'.

Implicit in the application are the necessity for certifications by one or two persons who are aware of the circumstances of the applicant that they come within the category of eligibility. It is recommended that any person proposing a 'special guest' for this type of holiday should contact management of the Foundation to ensure that what they propose is strictly in accordance with the Trust governing the activities of the Foundation if they are in any doubt.

It is desirable if the person attesting to the eligibility of a 'special guest' does so by a signature witnessed by a Justice of the Peace.
