Day Two

After a tasty breakfast we head off on a coastal tour stopping first at Shell World before taking in the sights of Bluff Rock, Double Island Point & the beauty of the Causeway Lake. Morning tea will be served at the Singing Ship. From this picturesque vantage point you can wander down the impressive memorial boardwalk that was designed to honour 100 years of ANZAC and features unique works by local artists. (BD)

Day Three

After breakfast we take a short drive to Rosslyn Bay and set out to beautiful Great Keppel Island by boat. There is an abundance of marine life to be enjoyed either by glass bottom boat or snorkelling off the beach. Or why not explore the island; its beauty will astound you while you soak up the ambience that is Great Keppel Island. Discover some of the 17 pristine beaches, numerous bays and coves waiting for you. (BLD)



Day Four

Today we head off to Henderson Park. It's truly a magical place where you can get up close to Mother Nature, the animals and the people who live here. The station specialises both in the breeding and fattening of Brahman, Brangus and Droughtmaster cattle. Situated on Headlow Creek it overlooks a massive floodplain from which Volcanic Plugs tower majestically over pasture land. It's no wonder Rockhampton is the beef capital of Australia with stations like Henderson Park (BD).

Day Five

After breakfast we head north to discover Byfield National Park & the rare Byfield fern only found here. The beauty of the area is breathtaking, the rugged mountains, rainforest edged creeks & ancient cycads are not to be missed. We stop for a cuppa at Nob Creek Pottery & Gallery which prides itself on exhibiting high quality craft from 45 craftspeople & artists set in a tropical wonderland. On return to Yeppoon enjoy some free time to explore the beachside towns' delightful welcoming atmosphere, browse the many boutiques and cafes. The parks and gardens offers natural flora and fauna enjoy the free show of little red & black flying foxes as they set out at sunset – an awesome sight. (BD)
